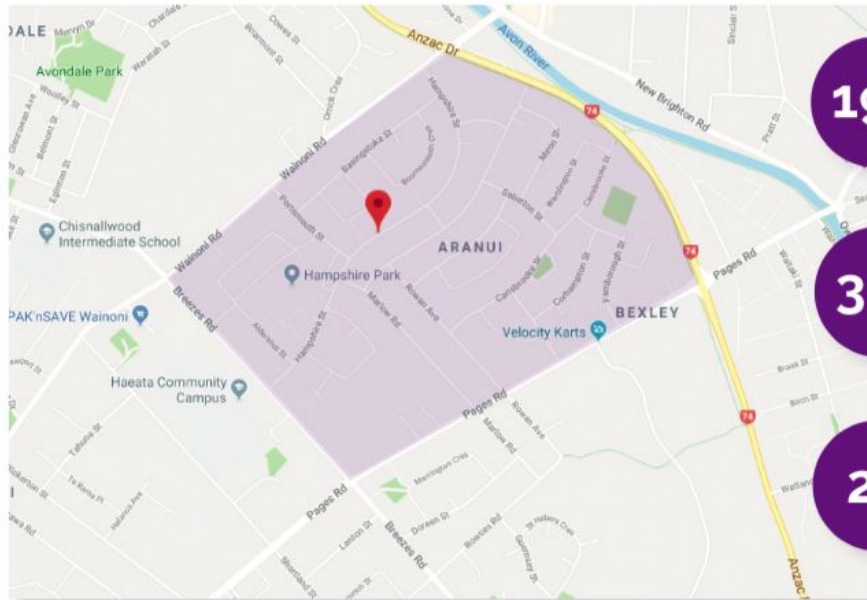

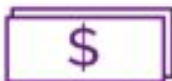

other options

If you were to look for other suitable options then here is a good checklist to consider when looking and deciding.

[note these are suggested minimum specs]

Wireless

Wireless capable - 802.11a/n Wifi and preferred 802.11ac (which indicates a 5GHz capable wireless card) as this gives the right speed and volume for the school network. Lesser wireless speeds can slow everyone down!

Screen

A screen large enough to work with documents in order to create and edit content.
Suggest 10" minimum screen size.

Battery

Long battery life. At least a 6 hour battery life.

Other considerations:

Weight - this will need to be carried around school with other school books

Robustness - sturdy enough for school use

Warranty - students using the device regularly will want faults fixed quickly

Insurance - make sure you are covered for replacement if lost or stolen

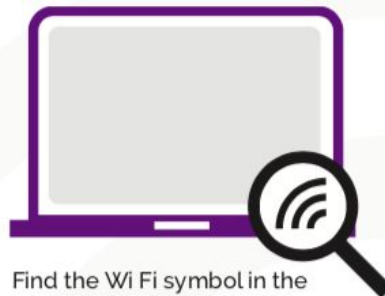

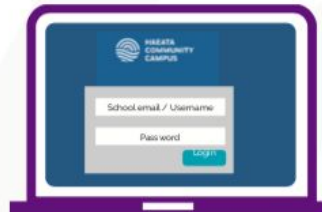
